### Certified Engineers (RHCEs) on Enterprise IT Performance

#### IT Staffing Is Key to Success of IT and Business

IT staffs are required to be with deep capability and understanding of the impact of technology on business. IT organizations will leverage these trends only to the extent that the IT staff can manage risk, balance IT staff productivity, implement projects successfully, and consistently use standards. These four key criteria are essential to ensure that businesses can effectively manage existing technologies and deploy new ones. Red Hat's popular performance-based certifications for system administration, Red Hat Certified Technician (RHCT) and RHCE, are examples of credentials that have a demonstrated impact on these four essential priorities.



#### Red Hat Linux Authorized Program

##### Module 1: Red Hat Linux Essentials (RH033)

An introduction to fundamental end-user and administrative tools in Red Hat Enterprise Linux, designed for students with little or no command-line Linux or UNIX experience.

##### Module 2: Red Hat Linux System Administration (RH131)

For users of Linux (or UNIX) who want to start building skills in systems administration on Red Hat Enterprise Linux 5, to a level where they can attach and configure a workstation on an existing network.

##### Module 3: Red Hat Linux Networking and Security Administration (RH253)

For Linux- and/or UNIX- systems administrators who want to build skills at configuring common network services and security administration using Red Hat Enterprise Linux.

##### Red Hat Certified Engineer (RHCE) Examination (RH302)

The certification examination consists of one part conducted in a single day session. The exam is performance-based, meaning that candidates must perform tasks on a live system, rather than answering questions about how one might perform those tasks.

*(Remarks: The RHCE examination consists of one section lasting 3.5 hours.)*

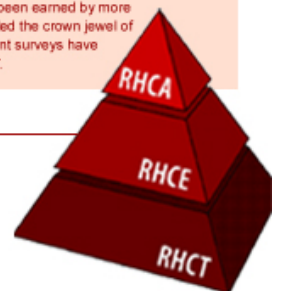
In order to pass the RHCE exam., candidates must meet ALL of the following requirements:

**70% or more on the RHCT-level skills.**  
**70% or more on the RHCE-level skills.**



These last two requirements enable RHCEs to demonstrate that they possess both RHCT-level and RHCE-level skills, as well as enabling a person who only has RHCT level skills to earn RHCT if they pass the required competencies.

RHCE began in 1999 and has been earned by more than 20,000 Linux experts. Called the crown jewel of Linux Certifications. Independent surveys have ranked the RHCE #1 in all of IT.
